PuTTY is a free implementation of Telnet and SSH for Win32 platforms, along with an xterm terminal emulator. It is written and maintained primarily by Simon Tatham. The latest version is beta 0.60b.

CONFIGURING PUTTY FOR EECS.YORKU

When you run PuTTY, it displays a "configuration" window. On the tree menu to the left, navigate to the <u>Session</u> setting. In "Host Name (or IP address)" type: **red.eecs.yorku.ca** Then, in the "Saved Sessions" type EECS.YORKU. Then click on the "Save" button.
